## Basic Rules for Using "Am," "Is," "Are"

1. Am: Use "am" with the subject "I." - Example: I am a student.

2. Is: Use "is" with singular subjects like "he," "she," "it," or singular nouns.

Example: She is a teacher.

3. Are: Use "are" with plural subjects like "we," "you," "they," or plural nouns.

Example: They are friends
