Basic Rules for Using "Am," "Is," "Are"

1. **Am:** Use "am" with the subject "I." - Example: I **am** a student.
2. **Is:** Use "is" with singular subjects like "he," "she," "it," or singular nouns.
Example: She **is** a teacher.
3. **Are:** Use "are" with plural subjects like "we," "you," "they," or plural nouns.
Example: They **are** friends
